- The list of courses should be used to maintain the integrity of the discipline, not to use literature to teach a discipline.
- The focus seems to contradict the breadth in the sample program.
- Clarify in the requirements how many courses can be taken at the 200- or 300-level.
- There was concern about the few number of courses offered in the Latin-American focus area.
- If this major can accommodate students that are interested in Language Arts Education, this should be included in the proposal.
