**Revision to the Chemistry major on the B.S. degree**

Approved unanimously.

**Proposal to establish an undergraduate major in Korean (re-submitted from Spring)**

Approved unanimously.

**Proposal to revise the ASC Aviation major core curriculum, changing the 3<sup>rd</sup> writing course**

The CCI needs additional information, and will invite Gerald Chubb to the next meeting.

Concerns center on the 3<sup>rd</sup> writing course requirements. Instead of a single course (Aviation 520), the proposal is to spread the third writing among multiple courses.

**Geological Sciences 108, for the Physical Sciences category**

Approved unanimously, contingent on adding the academic misconduct and disability services statements to the syllabus.

**Comparative Studies/African-American and African Studies 243, for the Cultures and Ideas category and the Social Diversity component**

Tabled. Subcommittees B & C will review the issues and will report back to the CCI. Note that Subcommittee C recommended approval for Social Diversity, but Subcommittee B did not recommend approval for Cultures and Ideas.

The main concern is that the texts used are chiefly analysis, and that some primary literature should be included, as the parent category is called "Analysis of Texts and Works of Art."

**Speech and Hearing Science 330/H330, for the Social Science category**

Approved unanimously.

**Music 142/252, change of title (course exists in the Visual and Performing Arts category)**

Approved unanimously.

**Linguistics/Near Eastern Languages and Culture 311, change of title, description, and change of number for Linguistics (course exists in the Cultures and Ideas category)**

Approved unanimously.
