In particular, they'd like special attention paid to elaborating on the exercises (as found on page 6 of the syllabus) and the amount of writing a student will be required to do to successfully complete the assignments.
 - The Subcommittee would like clarification on the format of the exams (e.g., multiple choice, short answer, essay; as discussed on page 6 of the syllabus).
 - The Subcommittee asks that the required Religious Accommodations statement be added to the course syllabus. The Religious Accommodations statement can be found on the <u>ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services website</u>.
