

Anticipated Recommendations & Reactions

Utilization

- 1. Re-enforce existing utilization standards with the goal of spreading courses more appropriately through the day and increasing Friday utilization.
 - Existing policy (applying to pool classrooms) calls for no more than 11% of a department's courses to be offered at a specific time, no more than 21.5% of courses on a specific day.
 - Scrutinizing courses scheduled for Spring 2009 and asking departments to adjust offering times if offering falls outside of policy.
 - Comparing utilization from Spring 2008 and Spring 2009 to view effects on utilization and consider adjustments to percentages and policy.

Communication, Ease of Use and Feedback

- 1. Inform faculty of the room assigned to them as early as possible to allow for opportunity to familiarize themselves with the room and request a different room if necessary.
 - Will be in place for Summer and Autumn 2009.
 - Communication from Registrar's Office.
- 2. Survey faculty about the room they are currently using.
 - Survey will be in place Winter 2009.
 - Will allow for opportunity to request a different type of room when course is taught in the future.
 - Will allow for reporting of improvements that need to be made both immediately and in future renovations.
- 3. Improve in-room instructions for installed technology.
 - Laminated instruction cards will be in place by Spring 2009
 - Renovation and technology upgrade projects include shift to a standard controlling system for AV and sound.
- 4. Inform faculty of classroom features to allow for better room matching.
 - Multiple websites in various departments currently exist that each communicates a piece of the full classroom characteristic picture.
 - A single consolidated website will launch for Summer 2009.
