## Curricular and Assessment Initiatives

## Calendar Conversion

- Throughout the year the CCI has discussed updates from faculty, administrators, college and CCl subcommittees on the topic of calendar conversion and the potential impact of calendar conversion on the GEC and Arts and Sciences. Tim Gerber visited the CCI on February 20, 2009 to present a preliminary model and answer questions.


## Discussion of Curricular Flow Process

- In an effort to increase efficiency while maintaining the rigor of the curricular vetting process within Arts and Sciences with calendar conversion in mind, the CCl considered several versions of proposed Curricular Flow Models throughout the year. After careful deliberation a triage system was developed for those requests deemed by the appropriate committee chair and the chair of the CCI . Triaged items may bypass college and/or CCI subcommittees in order to expedite requests. Some college committees incorporated their own versions of triage systems for fast-tracking courses, which has proven successful in decreasing time to approval for modest and/or batch course actions.


## GEC Structure

- The CCI Subcommittee on Arts and Humanities recommended the following change to the Arts and Humanities GEC category

> Within the GEC-R category of 2 .Breadth; C. Arts and Humanities, that the current requirement: "Select 10 credit hours from the following lists, with at least five credit hours from the literature section and five credit hours from the visual/performing arts section. A maximum of five hours is permitted from the area of the major, but these hours may not be counted on the major."
> Be changed to read:
> "Select 10 credit hours from any two of the three sections: (1) literature; (2) visual/performing arts; (3) Cultures and Ideas. A maximum of five hours is permitted from the area of the major, but these hours may not be counted on the major."

The CCI voted not to accept this recommendation.

- Insight Areas
o Following an examination of data gathered last year from A\&S programs on pre-existing courses containing elements that fall into the Insight Areas (Moral Reasoning; Visual Literacy; Technological Literacy; Diversity International Issues - Western; Diversity International Issues -non-Western, Global; and Social Diversity in the U.S.) the CCI voted to table further discussion of the incorporation and implementation of the Insight Areas into the GEC until the impact of semesters on the GEC are better defined.
o The revised "Guidelines for the GEC Diversity: International Issues Component" (May, 2007) made by the 2006-07 Insight Areas Diversity Task Force were adopted and incorporated into the current GEC Submission Guidelines and GEC Expected Learning Outcomes, providing clear and robust definitions and guidance for faculty and students.

Tibetan Book 3 Listing

- CCI approved a separate listing for "Tibetan" in Book 3, allowing students to locate more easily expanding course offerings in this area. The home department for Tibetan is East Asian Languages and Literatures.

Revision of the Fischer College of Business GEC-3 advising sheet

- A revision to the FCOB GEC-3 advising sheet for Business majors was approved by the CCI on November 21, 2008.


## Distance Learning

- The CCI discussed the current and potential role of Distance Learning courses in the GEC, including vetting and assessment processes for these courses. Representatives from the Technology Enhancement Learning and Research office and instructors teaching on-line GEC courses from within A\&S and outside of A\&S were present.

GEC Web Design and Template Display

- The CCI has been an ongoing discussion partner with the A\&S Curricular Associate Deans, A\&S Technology Services, and A\&S Advising to design a web site (gec.osu.edu) which will represent the Revised General Education Curriculum in a way that is both visually appealing and informative for students, faculty, and other consumers of this information. CCI endorsed the prototype and will be involved in the development process as it moves forward.

Assessment of GEC

- The CCl Subcommittee on Assessment met regularly in addition to meeting as a core group within the University Level Advisory Committee on the GEC, which reports to CAA. For details on the work of the ULAC-GEC see Report to the Council on Academic Affairs on the Status of the General Education Curriculum 2008.
- The fifth round of GEC course assessment began in November 2008 and focused on highenrollment regional campus courses as determined in cooperation with regional campus deans and faculty. Reports for approximately 25 courses are due in WI 2010. Some of the regional campuses reviewing common courses are working together (sometimes in conjunction with the Columbus campus) to submit course reports. Workshops, clinics, and individual consultations at the regional campuses were conducted by assessment representatives from the Office of Academic Affairs, the Arts and Sciences Curriculum and Assessment Office and the University Center for the Advancement of Teaching (formerly the Office of Faculty \& TA Development).
- The subcommittee established that Course Set 6 will consist of an additional round of 20-25 GEC courses taught at regional campuses, with reports due in 2011. Participants of Course Set 6 will be notified in summer.
- The subcommittee reviewed 18 GEC Course Reports and is in the process of providing feedback to departments. Reports indicate outcomes are being achieved and course-level assessment of student learning gains is ongoing although areas for improvement can be identified.
- Continuing category-level assessment of the GEC, the CCI Assessment Initiatives Subcommittee convened a faculty focus group of lead instructors for the GEC Second Writing (367) Skills Category, which was held on May 19, 2008. Faculty reported all GEC Writing and Related Skills expected outcomes were addressed in their courses. At the request of focus group participants and with the approval of the Assessment Initiatives Subcommittee, the A\&S Curriculum and Assessment Office set up a meeting of interested faculty along with the staff from the Center for the Study and Teaching of Writing to develop an optional grading rubric. The results of this workgroup were presented to the subcommittee and the development of rubric templates are in progress.
- As a follow up to the subcommittee's 2007-08 recommendation, the C\&AO has sent quarterly departmental reminders of the GEC requirements for instructors with appropriate learning objectives and a contact person for questions. These notifications are sent on behalf of the CCI Chair and have been well received.
- Based on a presentation and discussion in CCI of GEC Distance Learning courses, the subcommittee is investigating the process for assessment and vetting of distance learning courses.
- Based on a presentation of preliminary course assessment templates distributed by Richard Gunther, the CCl took a straw vote in favor of general support for moving forward with the
development of the initiative for this template to be made widely available, but not to preclude the development of other instruments at the request of the department, individuals, or CCI.

Assessment of A\&S Majors

- Two of the A\&S College Curriculum Committees met to discuss their annual majors reporting and ongoing efforts within their respective majors; three more are scheduled to have this discussion before the end of SP09. These productive discussions led to further collaboration among departments regarding methods of assessment and ideas for using assessment data to drive revisions to major programs. The reporting cycle will continue, with new reports from all programs due in July/August 2008. In addition, the College of the Arts and the College of Humanities are having a combined assessment workshop for majors reporting scheduled for May 21, 2009.
- Majors reporting this year will be done across the university using an on-line survey-style system developed by OAA. The data from these reports can be rolled up at the college and university level and will be made available internally. At a later date, summary data may be made available externally (contact Alexis Collier, OAA for details).

Freshman Seminars, Clusters, Professional Pathways Seminars, and Junior Seminars

- A separate report on these, including a new proposal for the creation of Junior Seminars will be submitted to the CCI for approval on June 12, 2009.


## Major Curricular Requests reviewed and approved by the A\&S CCI:

## Chinese Major Revision

The revision reinstates several intermediate- and advanced-level language courses due to an increase in student interest and enrollments, an increase in faculty resources, and the restructuring of the East Asian Languages and Literatures majors in 2007-08.

Linguistics Major Revision
This modest revision requires now that only Honors students take the research course required for the major, although non-honors majors will be encouraged to take the course. The current research course number, 595, has been changed to the official Undergraduate Research course number, 699, allowing transcript and tracking information to be more transparent. If enrollments warrant it, the department will add an Honors version of this 699 course.

Microbiology Major Revision This revision splits the 5-credit hour lecture and laboratory course (Microbiology 581) into two, three-credit hour courses consisting of a lecture (581.01) and a lab (581.02) course. This onecredit hour increase reflects the intensive work students are already doing, making maximum pedagogical use of laboratory time, and making it easier to schedule the required laboratory space.

Physics Major Revision
The changes add CSE 202 as a prerequisite to Physics 416 and Physics 416 as a prerequisite to Physics 555, 631, and 621 thus ensuring that students take courses in an order that best prepares them for upper-level coursework. This change was driven by student surveys and feedback, which indicated a desire for increased rigor resulting in better preparation for upperdivision major coursework, graduate study, and career placement.

Portuguese Major Revision
The proposal is the culmination of deliberate revisions and additions to the curriculum over the past several years. The changes, which do not entail an increase in required credit hours, were driven by expansion in both the size of the faculty and student interest and enrollments. The
revision strengthens the program's core and streamlines the structure of choices within the major's categories to make it more parallel in structure to the Spanish major which accommodates students with and without prior language proficiency in Spanish.

## Russian Major Revision

The Russian Major underwent significant revision, increasing the number of required credit hours from 43 to 50 hours and adding a new track to the existing traditional track. These changes will enhance the intellectual rigor of the major, accommodate long-standing trends within the discipline, and bring it in line with comparable majors in the Arts and Sciences and across benchmark institutions. The rationale for the addition of a culture studies focus is both faculty- and student-driven.

## Spanish Major Revision

The proposal to revise the Spanish Major maintains the current total number of credit hours while responding to increasing popularity of the major and increased preparation and ability of incoming students. Like majors at benchmark institutions, the revision adds structure and depth to the program by creating four specialized tracks. The structure of the core courses and ensuing tracks allows students to enter the major at beginner as well as advanced levels of language proficiency. It also provides flexibility for students to switch tracks should their interests shift. The major is the first of its kind here at Ohio State that requires a study abroad component, which can also be satisfied by a 100-hour Ohio immersion experience.
