Proposal to Modify the Core Requirements for Bachelor of Music in Composition and Bachelor of Arts in Music

School of Music The Ohio State University

The following is a proposal to modify the major requirements for the Bachelor of Music in Composition and the Bachelor of Arts in Music. The BM degree provides pre-professional training for musicians in music composition. The BA degree is designed for the student that wants to study music in the context of a broad liberal arts degree. Students who choose this major have varied goals, ranging from vocational music activities to graduate study in music theory, musicology, or in an unrelated field such as law. The BA music degree is also a good choice for a student pursuing a double major. We would like to fully implement these changes in Autumn Quarter of 2011.

The School recommends these proposed changes in response to concerns voiced by the School's accreditation body, the National Association of Schools of Music (NASM). With respect to the BM in Composition, NASM stated that the number of required composition courses required in the major was insufficient. Their concerns regarding the BA in Music were similar. They stated that the number of applied lessons required of our BA students was also insufficient.

The Theory/Composition area and the School's curriculum and administrative committees, vetted the BM in Composition beginning in the Autumn of 2010. The School's faculty voted to approve the program's amendments on October 13, 2010. The results of the vote were 39 in favor and 0 opposed with 0 abstentions. There are 56 regular faculty members in the School of Music.

The BA in Music was vetted within the curriculum and administrative committees in the Autumn of 2010. The School's faculty voted to approve the program's amendments on October 13, 2010. The results of the vote were 39 in favor and 0 opposed with 0 abstentions. There are 56 regular faculty members in the School of Music.

In the BM in Composition, we have removed the music elective credits in the current program, totaling 10 hours, and placed those credits into the music theory and composition category. As noted in the 'small print' under the current program's music electives category, composition students were advised to take additional composition courses within the music elective block so, from the student's point of view, no additional course work will be required of them as a result of this proposal. Three (3) hours of Music 630, Composers Seminar, were moved from the ensembles category and into the music theory and composition category, a more appropriate position given the goals of that course. With the proposed restructuring of this program, the total credit load in it remains the same at 182. The School of Music plans to allow current students pursuing the Bachelor of Music in Composition degree to finish the degree under the existing plan or to choose to finish the degree under the new plan.

The extra 9 credits in the proposed program were taken from the university electives, which total 33 credits in the current program. In the proposed program, the number of university electives will total 24 credits. The credit total for the entire program will remain at 181 under the proposed plan. The School of Music plans to allow current students pursuing the Bachelor of Arts in Music to finish the degree under the existing plan or choose to finish the degree under the new plan. Access to applied lessons will continue to be by permission of the instructor through the end of Spring Quarter 2011.
