Synopsis

The goal of this seminar is to provide to students sufficient breadth and depth of information concerning the biological mechanisms underlying host-pathogen interactions. Information will be gained through discussion and presentation by students, postdoctoral researchers, OSU faculty, and invited outside speakers. Speakers will provide information from different perspectives, but all will be from the point of view of their ongoing research on mechanisms of host-pathogen interactions. This will distinguish these presentations from those available in other seminars and courses in the IBGP core curriculum.
