
Dear Ed,

The College of the Arts Curriculum Committee has reviewed and voted unanimously to support the Department of History of Art's proposal to propose Historical Studies GEC status for History of Art 201: *History of Western Art I: The Ancient World to the Early Renaissance* and History of Art 202: *History of Western Art II: The Renaissance to Contemporary Worlds*. We discussed the proposal with Dr. Lisa Florman, Associate Chair of the Department of History of Art during our ARTS CC deliberations on Thursday, November 1, 2007, and we were pleased to unanimously support HA 201 and 202 as Historical Study category courses.

As well, we feel that the appropriate placement of these two sequential lower level survey courses will be in Category A. Category B courses appear to be at the 300 level and above and are not in sequences. While we understand students now are not required to take a survey/sequence in the Historical Study Category, the Department of History of Art would like to see HA 201 and 202 placed in category A.
