Assessment Plan

The success of the course in achieving the goals and objectives of the relevant category of the GEC will be assessed in three ways:

- Instructors will conduct a Carmen survey designed to elicit the students' perception of the success of the course in fostering the relevant GEC goals and objectives.
- Instructors will determine the relevance of specific graded assignments to the particular GEC goals and objectives and examine student performance on the separate assignments to determine whether that performance indicates successful achievement of those goals and objectives.
- Instructors will write and submit to the department's Teaching Evaluation Committee a short narrative detailing overall student performance with respect to the various course objectives.
