New Course Request

Given the duties of citizenship and the large role of the law in everyday life, there is need for a course that equips students to apply the basic tools of critical thinking to the assessment of legal reasoning in particular. Through examination of various courtroom scenarios and actual court cases, students will be taught to reason carefully about what laws are involved and how those laws apply.
