Note: Admittance in the BAE (Bachelor of Art Education) is competitive, by application and portfolio review.

To apply to the BAE program, you must first be admitted to the BA Art program (successfully completed an initial portfolio review in art) and have completed Art ED 225. Other requirements for application are listed in the *BAE & MA with Licensure Information, Handbook, and Application Packet*. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 is required in the BAE program (including transfer credit) and for matriculation into the MA with Licensure. Matriculation into the MA with Licensure is required for an initial license to teach pk-12 art in Ohio.

You must follow the requirements of the BAE program, and schedule and complete a consultation with an Arts Advisor at the earliest possible date to ensure compliance. Prior to applying to the BAE, you must have this form completed, signed, and dated by an Arts Advisor. That copy must be included in the application materials for the BAE. A meeting with the Chair of the Undergraduate Art Education and Licensure Committee is also recommended.
