Clarification of Project & Portfolio Grading
Explanation of Project 6, Web-Based Portfolio

Tutorials are in-class exercises that are used in teaching new 3D concepts, such as revsurf, dimensioning, fillet, chamfer, etc. The course materials section of the syllabus (p.1) has changed to explain this. All tutorials are available in the CARMEN site for the course. They are in-class exercises, and thus not graded.

Projects 2 - 7 are graded at 10% each, as noted in the grade breakdown. Project 6 and the Portfolio were muddled, and that language has been clarified to more accurately represent and distinguish each assignment. Project 6 consists of an introduction to website design for theatre designers and technicians. It involves looking at effective and not-so effective sites and talking about what a theatre practitioner might likely have on his/her site. The website design will be graded on the student's design and layout of a set of typical linked pages, such as a home page, a contact page, a coursework page, and an "art" page that reflects their individual theatre experiences.

The web portfolio project is described as the web-based presentation of portfolio materials, based on the Project 6 website design. The portfolio also reflects work students have completed in the graphics courses (621.01 and 621.02) as well as individual design and/or technology projects, depending on the student's individual work completed to date.
