They have a strong background in another Romance language and are ready for an intensive course in Italian. (These students are bored and dissatisfied in the regular elementary 101-104 classes.) 2) In the near future we expect to create a major in the Romance languages, which will require students to have different degrees of experience in at least three Romance languages. Intensive language courses will be necessary in order for students to complete their requirements for this major in a timely manner. Intensive courses exist in French and Spanish, but not in Italian.
