Comparative Studies supports the English proposal to offer a new course to further diversify its offerings that satisfy the "Issues of the Contemporary World" component of the GEC. Comparative Studies currently offers two decimalized versions of the capstone course and plans soon to propose a "Global Folklore" class as a third decimal section, and possibly an additional version (the anticipated title is "Engineering in Global Perspective"), but neither would overlap with English 597.02. Under these circumstances it's practical and appropriate that the two departments offer distinct versions of 597; in this case there is little overlap with any CS version, given that our 597.02 is focused more on globalization per se than on U.S. issues in particular.
