Cognitive and metacognitive listening strategies presented in this course will develop learners' abilities to understand main ideas, note specific details, detect sequencing, follow directions, make inferences, predict outcomes, and evaluate listening input. Spanish 240 is designed to prepare undergraduate learners for the demands of 400 courses in Hispanic literatures, cultures, and linguistics.

Student interest and the course content of Spanish 240 are adaptable to the II format without compromising the course objectives or outcomes. This will be the first in a series of II course to be proposed and taught in Spanish.
