

The following course requests reflect the on-going efforts by the Department of Dance to review and modify our course offerings.

DANCE 211.01 & 615

- Currently all freshmen are required to take 615 Music Skills. We are requesting a change of the course number. The content of the current 615 will be offered in 211.01.
- There is new content and title for 615 Sound Design for Dance.

DANCE 211.02

- Currently all freshmen are required to take Improvisation; it is offered as 601.08 Supplemental Studies in Dance: OTHER. We are requesting a new course with a number that reflects the first year progression from 211.01 Music Skills, 211.02 Improvisation & 211.03 Introduction to Composition.

DANCE 634

- Costuming Design and Construction for Dance is a proposed new course successfully offered as a 694 Sp'09. We would like to offer it regularly in the future.

DANCE 801.61

- 801.61 was formerly taught in a two-quarter sequence with students taking 1 credit hour in each quarter and only focusing on teaching one class. We are changing the format of this course from a two-quarter offering of 1 credit each to a one-quarter offering of 3 credits. The revised course includes readings on dance in higher education, methodological approaches to teaching dance, and theoretical concepts used in dance pedagogy. This inclusion of materials is a reflection of the field and includes multiple readings that were not available when the course was first conceived. Both old and new syllabi are included.
