Recently the Undergraduate Studies Committee revisited the Women's Studies major concentration area requirement. Previously students could only apply designated Women's Studies courses to the 15-credit hour concentration area. The proposed change would allow students to apply the approved-related courses to the 15-credit hour concentration area.

Currently, students may only apply a maximum of 10-credit hours of non-Women's Studies approvedrelated courses to their major. The proposed change would not alter this maximum course limit.
