Dear Mindy—

I am writing to inform you that **ASC 337** Introduction to Nonprofit Organizations was **approved with contingencies** by the CCI Interdisciplinary Subcommittee at its 3-18-10 meeting. The Subcommittee would like the following changes to be made:

- 1. Add an exclusion to both ASC 337 and ASC 338.05 prohibiting concurrent enrollment
- 2. Add an exclusion to ASC 338.05 that if a student has taken ASC 337, he/she cannot take ASC 338.05. (This way, a student who becomes interested in non-profits while taking ASC 338.05 could still take the non-profit minor afterwards—and, as part of it, ASC 337. Indeed, the subcommittee assumes 337 will be a core course for the minor.)

Since the ECA form for ASC 337 is in our office's queue (and you no longer have access to that form), I can easily make the changes that pertain to 337 for you: i.e., add an exclusion prohibiting concurrent enrollment with 338.05. Please let me know that I can go ahead and change the ECA form for you.

On your side, you will have to introduce a course change request for ASC 338.05 in ECA. The course change will have to address the following points: (1) add an exclusion prohibiting concurrent enrollment with 337 and (2) add an exclusion that the course is not open to students who already have credit for ASC 337.

At its meeting, the Subcommittee also indicated that it will be interested in monitoring the overlap between the courses (especially as far as speakers are concerned) once the courses have been offered once or twice. Moreover, the subcommittee will pay attention to how the non-profit minor is built—if and how the professional pathways course is involved in the minor.
