Good question, and I may need a bit of guidance here since this is the first Sexuality Studies course we've proposed. Because the course can be taught in different ways by different faculty in different departments and colleges, my sense is that we need to leave the prereqs pretty flexible. What about this: sophomore standing, declared Sexuality Studies Minor or Major, or permission of instructor. Does that sound appropriate?

I don't yet have a specific number for the course, but perhaps 620 since we might want to keep the lower numbers available for introductory type courses?

By the way, Professor Amy Bonomi of HDFS is actually teaching a pilot version of the course for us this Spring as a 694. They capped the course at 50, and it's full with a waitlist of 1. So we have high hopes for the popularity of the course in our curriculum.
