(http://asccas.osu.edu/files/asccas/pdf/CCIManual.pdf). You are encouraged to use the exact wording approved by CCI on their operational syllabus for the course. For convenience, I am pasting the pertinent text here:

"Students with disabilities that have been certified by the Office for Disability Services will be appropriately accommodated and should inform the instructor as soon as possible of their needs. The Office for Disability Services is located in 150 Pomerene Hall, 1760 Neil Avenue; telephone 292-3307, TDD 292-0901; http://www.ods.ohio-state.edu/."

## (The handbook recommends that this language appear in 16 point font on a syllabus).

 Likewise, in your operational syllabus, it is recommended that you use an overall grading scale (can use other information than percentages). This will be a helpful guide for freshmen (who will probably have little or no experience with college-level grading scales). A grading scale will help students see clearly how grades on individual assignments will lead to their overall grade.
