> >>>>>>>>>>>>I have solicited feedback from DLLR and English Ed faculty

> members on  
> >>>>>>the new Graduate Literacy courses proposed by Harvey Graff.  
> The  
> >>>>>>course proposals were circulated for feedback from the  
> literacy  
> >>>>>>faculty in Ed T&L. Through a series of emails and  
> conversations,  
> >>>>>>issues were raised, responded to, and resolved. The courses  
> under  
> >>>>>>discussion were "Literacy Past and Present," and  
> "Introduction to  
> >>>>>>Graduate Study in Literacy."  
> >>>>>>  
> >>>>>>In terms of the Literacy Past and Present Course, the T&L  
> faculty did  
> >>>>>>see some overlap with a few courses in education. However,  
> this  
> >>>>>>overlap is quite limited and, in fact, productive. The  
> faculty agree  
> >>>>>>that this course looks to be an ideal course for T&L  
> graduate  
> >>>>>>students. It has enough overlap to provide some consistency  
> across  
> >>>>>>courses and concepts without seeming redundant. The T&L  
> faculty look  
> >>>>>>forward to having many of our graduate students take this  
> course.>>>>>>  
> >>>>>>In terms of the Introduction to Graduate Study in Literacy  
> course,  
> >>>>>>the T&L faculty raised some issues regarding course overlap  
> and focal  
> >>>>>>areas, all of which were addressed by Professor Graff. The  
> one issue  
> >>>>>>that remains pertains to the course title. Professor Graff  
> would  
> >>>>>>like to see the course cross listed in Ed T&L; however, some  
> T&L  
> >>>>>>faculty are reluctant to have the course listed without a  
> title  
> >>>>>>change. Some faculty feel that the current title seems a  
> bit broad,  
> >>>>>>and it seems to signal that this is "the" first or  
> introductory  
> >>>>>>course that one should take in pursuit of graduate literacy  
> studies  
> >>>>>>here at OSU. T&L faculty were wondering if there was a way

> to  
> >>>>>signal, more clearly, what this course is about, distinct  
> from many  
> >>>>>of the pre-existing courses here in ED T&L. This move would  
> more  
> >>>>>clearly distinguish the proposed course from many others in  
> ED T&L  
> >>>>>and make it even more appealing to students in our programs.

> >>>>>Professor Graff has proposed the following in response:  
> >>>>>  
> >>>>>The English posting of the "approaches" course has to remain  
> >>>>>"Introduction to Graduate Study in Literacy." That's the way  
> the  
> >>>>>curriculum is organized and expressed. That title addresses  
> students  
> >>>>>working through English, not Education. Let's title the  
> Education  
> >>>>>posting: "Literacy Studies: Social and Cultural Approaches,"  
> or  
> >>>>>Social and Cultural Approaches (or Perspectives) on Literacy  
> Studies.">>>>>  
> >>>>>I am cc-ing this message to all of the DLLR and English  
> Education  
> >>>>>faculty. Provided there are no further comments or  
> concerns, I would  
> >>>>>appreciate if you could communicate to Ed Adelson that we  
> have  
> >>>>>discussed and resolved any issues around the courses, and  
> that we are  
> >>>>>happy to offer our concurrence.
