Hi, Scot -

The Arts & Humanities 2 committee reviewed the revised Disabilities Studies minor, and we voted to send it on to the full CCI for review, pending a response to the following issues:

- o WS1110 is still in minor. This course should be removed, or else asterisked on the semester advising sheet to note that, if taken, the minimum hours for the minor increase to 15 (i.e, 12, the minimum for an ASC minor, plus 3).
- o The ASC rule of 6 hours at the 3000-level or higher should be explicitly stated on the advising sheet.
- o Also on the semester advising sheet the range of 14-17 credit hours at beginning of the advising sheet and of 8-11 credit hours for additional course work should be replaced with 14 and 8, respectively.
- o The list of courses on starting on page 5 of the PDF and on the advising sheet lists Social Work courses with quarter numbers. The semester numbers should be used, if they are available, and, if these are graduate-level courses (as they appear to be), the proposal should included a statement explaining why these courses are appropriate for the minor.
- o Also on the list of courses on page 5, the question marks after the Nisonger courses 5718.01 and 5718.02 should be removed.
- o In the program rationale statement on page 5, the word ?person? in the last line should be replaced by ?personal.?

Otherwise, it looks good! Please let me or Valarie Williams know if you have any questions.
