PORTUGUESE MAJOR FOUR YEAR PLAN – QUARTERS

The major program requirements in Portuguese include:

- *A minimum of 15 credit hours in advanced language and linguistics, including Portuguese 401: Advanced Portuguese Grammar*
- *A minimum of 25 credit hours in literatures and cultures, including Portuguese 450: Intro to the Study of Literatures and Cultures*
- *A minimum of 10 credit hours in Electives, students may choose any course in the electives list or from the "advanced language/linguistics" or "literature and culture" lists for a total of 50 hours required for the major.*

This particular program takes advantage of the student's interest in culture and literacy. The program presented here assumes placement into Portuguese 101 OR Portuguese 501 (for students who have studied Spanish previously) at the start of the freshman year (OPTION A and OPTION B below, respectively). You may place at a lower or a higher level. The departmental academic advisor will facilitate proper placement and work with you to select the courses that best fit your needs and interests.

PORTUGUESE MAJOR FOUR YEAR PLAN – SEMESTERS

The major program requirements in Portuguese include:

- *A minimum of 9 credit hours in advanced language and linguistics, including Portuguese 3401: Advanced Portuguese Grammar*
- *A minimum of 15 credit hours in literatures and cultures, including Portuguese 3450: Intro to the Study of Literatures and Cultures*
- *A minimum of 6 credit hours in Electives, students may choose any course in the electives list or from the "advanced language/linguistics" or "literature and culture" lists for a total of 30 hours required for the major.*
