Dear Professor Allen -

As chair of the Arts and Humanities 2 subcommittee of CCI, I am happy to inform you that our subcommittee voted unanimously at its meeting last Wednesday (May 18) to send the American Indian Studies Minor on to the full CCI, pending a few clarifications and corrections. Here are the relevant portions of the meeting minutes:

- > A letter from Dean Williams needs to be included (she'll take care of this)
- > Semester advising sheet:
 - o Still refers to 100-level courses and the GEC (rather than GE)

o Should include the paragraph about electives being approved by coordinating advisor that is found in rationale on previous page. Indeed, this paragraph explains the rationale for not listing all the Global Indigenous and Comparative Ethnic Studies courses.

o Information in footnote (*Note...) should be presented in another format than a footnote (because it leads the reader to believe that the note refers to another asterisk in the body of the advising sheet). In fact, this note could probably simply be deleted, because the information will be covered in the item above.

Also, I have in my notes (although it is not in the committee minutes) that in the second paragraph of the semester advising sheet the information starting with "Three courses (9 credit hours)..." could be deleted since it may no longer apply under semesters. This is also where the information about electives being approved by the coordinating advisor could go.

I hope this is clear, but please let me or Valarie Williams know if you have any questions.
