Hi Dan,

Hope your new year has started well!

This is about CSE 2111 which is the semester version of CSE 200. We are seeking GE status for the course in the "Mathematical and Logical Analysis" category (the second subcategory under "Quantitative and Logical Skills"). The course has Math 130/1130 as a pre-req. The purpose of the GE status for CSE 2111 is not that students will take it to meet the Math & Logical Analysis course requirement but rather that they will be able to use it as an "Open GE course". This is clarified in the "Note" on the first page of the course proposal (and assessment plan) of which I am attaching a copy.

The proposal was discussed by the NMS Panel at its meeting a couple of days ago. The panel approved the proposal and suggested that I send a message to you about it. They also had suggestions for changes in the proposal details and those have been incorporated in the file that I attach below. Any comments you may have would be most welcome.
