On Thursday, January 26, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed Modern Greek 2100 (Culture and Ideas & Global Studies GE) and 2240H (Culture and Ideas).

Modern Greek 2100: The Panel approved the course with contingency. The Panel would like the Dept to make the following small changes:

- Suggestion about font size of disability statement (recommended 16-point).

- Add boilerplate language for 2 GE categories (goals and expected learning outcomes)
- Change references to GEC to GE
