Hello Becky,

On Thursday, February 16, the ASCC (ASC Curriculum Committee) Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel reviewed Geography 3601 for Global Studies GE addition and Geography 2500 for Social Sciences: Organizations and Politics & Global Studies GE addition. Both courses were unanimously approved for these GE categories.

The Panel had a few suggestions about the proposals, which I am here communicating for your consideration:

- Recommendations for syllabus: (1) Add actual GE goals on syllabus; (2) refer to "GE" instead of "GEC."
- Assessment plan: SEIs do not specifically pertain to GE; they are questions pertaining to instruction. Suggestion: Provide indirect assessment method. (If Geography has assessment methods already in place, these could be used.)
