On Wednesday, April 18, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed the concurrence issue regarding Comparative Studies 5626. The Panel unanimously approved the course with one contingency—namely, the syllabus needs to include a 14-week schedule (or be consistent with the academic calendar). [As we did previously, if you want to send me a revised syllabus via e-mail, I can attach it to the course.]

Subsequently, on Friday, April 20, the matter was taken up by the full ASC Curriculum Committee. The Committee voted to approve the course (8 votes in favor, 6 opposed). The ASCC vote will now be presented as a recommendation to Executive Dean Steinmetz, who will make a final decision on the contingency issue.
