On Wednesday, April 18, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed the concurrence issue regarding Comparative Studies 5626. The Panel unanimously approved the course with one contingency—namely, the syllabus needs to include a 14-week schedule (or be consistent with the academic calendar). Subsequently, on Friday, April 20, the matter was taken up by the full ASC Curriculum Committee. The Committee voted to approve the course (8 votes in favor, 6 opposed).
