This note to let you know that on Wednesday, April 4, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed the concurrence issue regarding Comparative Studies 5626.

The Panel feels that the concurrence discussion has brought up some very interesting ideas that have not yet been incorporated in the syllabus that was provided to the Panel members. Therefore, the Panel would like to see a revised syllabus (with the latest title) for the course. An updated syllabus would better reflect the true intent of the course. It would, for example, provide a better explanation of how the readings relate to the course goals. Foremost, a revised syllabus would reflect Professor Holland's points. Right now Panel members have to infer much about the course based on Professor Holland's letter. (This way, the case for the course would be stated in the syllabus rather than in a series of exchanges between the departments.) The Panel feels strongly that the course proposal will be enhanced by incorporating Professor Holland's compelling rebuttal in the syllabus.

As far as the logistics are concerned, the course is in my curriculum.osu.edu queue and I can easily attach the revised syllabus when you send it to me. (That way the course does not have to be sent back to the unit.)
