On Wednesday, May 2, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed and approved the semester conversion proposal for the Critical and Cultural Theory Minor.

However, before the minor moves on the general ASCC, the Panel would like the following points addressed. I will send back the proposal via curriculum.osu.edu to enable the department to make the necessary changes. If you could send back the proposal before next Friday, that will enable us to put the proposal on the ASCC agenda for 5-18-12.

- Cover letter: Geography 5643 “Geographies of Governmentalities” should be 5601 and is in category C (not B). It is the conversion of Geography 643, which was already included in the quarter version—was added to the minor in 2009. The reference to this course should probably be removed from the letter.
- Remove the 1000-level language in the semester advising sheet (right column). This language will no longer appear on ASC semester advising sheets.
- There is no rule against keeping the WGGSt course (2550) in the minor since lower-level courses are allowed in minors (as long as 6 credits or more are at the upper-level). Except if the Dept prefers to have all upper-level courses in this minor, you may wish to keep this course.
