On June 7, the Education Abroad GE Ad-hoc Panel reviewed UH 2396H for Education Abroad GE status. The Panel unanimously approved the course.

One member would like to recommend that the relation between "Great Britain," "United Kingdom," and "England" be made clear early on in the syllabus.

Also, I want to point out that the syllabus should include the Education Abroad goals (as well as the expected learning outcomes). In other words, this whole passage should be included verbatim:

## Goals:

By living and studying outside the U.S, students acquire and develop a breadth of knowledge, skills, and perspectives across national boundaries that will help them become more globally aware.

## **Expected Learning Outcomes:**

- 1. Students recognize and describe similarities, differences, and interconnections between their host country/countries and the U.S.
- 2. Students function effectively within their host country/countries.
- 3. Students articulate how their time abroad has enriched their academic experience.

When the scoring rubric is finalized, I will e-mail it to you (together with brief instructions on how the faculty should be using the rubric).

UH 2396H will be a welcome addition to the current General Education curriculum. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.
