Hi Rachel.

On Friday, October 26, the Arts and Humanities (A&H) Panel of the Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee (ASCC) reviewed the new course requests for <u>Portuguese 2798.10</u> (Contemporary Issues in Brazil) and <u>Spanish 2798.11</u> (Bolivia). The A&H Panel reviewed both courses *as courses only*—the request for GE Education Abroad will next be considered by the GE Education Abroad adhoc panel.

<u>Portuguese 2798.10</u> was unanimously approved. The Panel did have several recommendations re: the syllabus:

- At beginning of syllabus, add Education Abroad GE goals and expected learning outcomes followed by brief explanatory paragraph on how course fulfills the GE learning outcomes.

- Recommended 16 point for disability statement.
- Academic misconduct link is broken

The first recommendation especially is a change that the GE Education Abroad ad-hoc panel will wish to see (i.e., the ad-hoc panel is likely to consider this a contingency precluding full approval). Therefore, in order to best prepare the course for review by the GE Education Abroad ad-hoc panel, I will return the course so that you can make the changes.

<u>Spanish 2798.11</u> was unanimously approved with one contingency and one recommendation:

- · Contingency: Readings should be reflected in weekly schedule.
- Recommendation: Recommended 16 point for disability statement.

I will send back Spanish 2798.11 as well. The contingency is a change that will need to be made for the course to be fully approved. (While the recommendation is exactly that—just a recommendation.)
