Hello Rachel,

At its meeting of January 14, the ASCC Ad Hoc GE Education Abroad Panel reviewed and <u>unanimously approved</u> the following courses for GE Education Abroad status: *Portuguese 2798.10*, *Spanish 2798.11*, and *Spanish 2798.12*.

The Panel did have one recommendation for Spanish 2798.11, namely:

• The program includes 2 weeks in country with work on research proposal before and after trip. Suggestion that the syllabus emphasize that Carmen documents need to be accessed pre-departure (as this is likely the case). If some readings (or other assignments) need to be done pre-departure, indicate that too.

This recommendation is not something that needs to be taken care of immediately (for curricular approval). Rather, the Panel believes that this clarification would be very useful to students when the course is actually taught.

Portuguese 2798.10, Spanish 2798.11, and Spanish 2798.12 will next move to full ASCC for a two-week comment period.
