On Friday, October 12, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed Japanese 5310 & Japanese 5311. The Panel did not take a vote on the proposals as it would like the following changes to be made first:

- Japanese 5310
  - Provide a weekly schedule with readings from the two required textbooks or further explanation of why a weekly or daily schedule is not appropriate for this course syllabus.
  - Provide information to students of where the textbooks are available.
  
- Japanese 5311
  - There are no readings or assignments in the weekly schedule. Needs fleshed out or further explanation of why a schedule of assignments and readings is not appropriate for this course syllabus.
  - The grading scale states “approximately.” Further explanation why “approximately” was used or remove it from the grading scale.
  - Academic Misconduct link needs to be updated (<http://studentlife.osu.edu/csc/>)
  - Are there required or optional texts? If so, they need to be reflected in the weekly schedule.

I will send back the proposal via curriculum.osu.edu to enable you to make the changes.
