Dear Mary,

On Friday, January 25, the ASC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed a new course proposal for History of Art 2005. I am happy to report that the Panel *unanimously approved* the course for GE Visual and Performing Arts & GE Historical Study.

A few recommendations were made by the faculty panel. I list these recommendations below:

- *P. 1 of syllabus: "History of Art 2005 fulfills both the Visual and Performing Arts and the Historical Study section of the General Education Curriculum requirement." Put "either ... or" instead of "both ... and" between GE categories (since a course cannot fulfill both GE requirements for one student).*
- *Request to use boilerplate language for disability statement and academic misconduct statement (with appropriate weblinks). See p. 13 of curriculum manual: https://ascas.osu.edu/sites/ascas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual_2012-13_.pdf*
- *In the grading scale, 67 can be both D+ or D.*

The course will next move to the full ASC Curriculum Committee for a two-week comment period.

On another note, the effective term selected in curriculum.osu.edu for this course is SU13. However, the OUR deadline for SU13 courses is past. At this point, OUR is accepting courses for SP2014. (See here: <http://ascas.osu.edu/curriculum/important-deadlines>). Please let me know whether I can change the effective term to SP14 or whether you wish to submit a rationale to appeal the deadline.
