The Curriculum Committee of the Research and Graduate Council returned to the processing of your proposal for a Graduate Interdisciplinary Specialization in Disability Studies at its meeting yesterday. The Committee was quite impressed with the revisions that had been made to your proposal from last Spring, the clarification of some earlier budgetary concerns, and the widespread documentation of support that you have received for the proposal. I am delighted to report that your proposal received the unanimous endorsement from the Committee as well as a recommendation for allotting \$14,540, as per your budgetary request, to the proposal's development and implementation.
