Dear Julie and Alisa,

At their respective meetings of December 7 and December 15, the ASCC Arts and Humanities and the ASCC SBS Panels met to review some curricular requests. Both panels looked at the requested course changes for Linguistics 5700 and Psychology 5700 (cross-listed courses).

The A&H and SBS Panels reached the same conclusion that the activities and objectives of the “first” class and the “repeated” class appear to be different. Therefore, the Panels believe that the “repeated” course should be a different course—i.e., be submitted as a new course with a different number (possibly a decimalized number). (For example, 5700.01 would be the number for the first class and 5700.02 would be the number for the repeated class.) Both Panels also would like to see a new, detailed syllabus for the repeat course (a syllabus that provides more information about what students will do in the class / what the value is of the repeat course).
