Dear Randy,

On Friday, January 25, the ASC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed proposals to add GE Diversity Global Studies to History 2650, 3282, and 3570, and to add Diversity in the US to History 3075.

I am happy to report that the Panel *unanimously approved* all those requests to add GE status.

A couple of recommendations were made by the faculty panel. I list these recommendations below:

- *For future submissions, make sure not to leave references to the "GEC". Under semesters, the "GE" is used.*
- *For History 3570, on the syllabus, add "GE Global Studies" at the end of paragraph one.*

The courses will next move to the full ASC Curriculum Committee for a two-week comment period.

On another note, if the Dept of History is planning on offering these courses this Autumn, could you please respond to this e-mail and simply indicate that OAA's deadline needs to be appealed (since AU 13 course requests are no longer accepted by OAA/OUR without an appeal).
