On Tuesday, March 5, the Ad Hoc GE Service-Learning Panel reviewed Sociology 2211S for GE Service-Learning status. I am happy to report that the course was unanimously approved for the requested GE status.

The Panel did have the following 2 recommendations:

- Recommendation to line up end-of-course assignment instructions with three expected learning outcomes to make assessment easier. That is, map the writing prompt to assessment rubric more clearly.
- On syllabus: Request to add GE goals and expected learning outcomes with explanation on how these are fulfilled in the course.

Regarding the necessary GE Service Learning goals and expected learning outcomes (ELOs) followed by a short paragraph of how the ELOs are fulfilled in the course, the Panel will be satisfied with the faculty member's assurance that that language will be on the syllabus when the course is offered next. Or you can send me an updated syllabus, which I will attach to the course package.

Sociology 2211S will next advance to the full ASC Curriculum Committee for a two-week comments period.
