Randy,

The ASC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed course change requests for History 3003, 3014, and 3216 at its meeting of April 12, 2013.

1. History 3003 (existing course requesting addition of GE Diversity in the US). The Panel *did not take a vote* but would like the following matter to be addressed first:
The GE explanation for Social Diversity in the US (p. 4 of syllabus) is compelling, but the diversity concepts are not reflected in the schedule. The course seems to be more about the mechanics of party politics in the US than about topics like disenfranchised sections of the population, ethnicity in early elections, etc. Schedule needs to represent the ideas in the GE rationale.
2. History 3014 (existing course requesting addition of GE Diversity in the US) Request *unanimously approved*.
3. History 3216 (existing course requesting addition of GE Diversity Global Studies) Request *approved with contingencies* below:
 - P. 4 of syllabus: Requirements: grades add up to 85%; Enrollment: Replace reference to “quarter” with semester.”
 - P. 9 of syllabus: Grading scale includes a D-, which grade does not exist at OSU.

I will return History 3003 and 3216 via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the department to address those points.
