On Tuesday, April 23rd, the ASCC Honors Panel reviewed Econ 4050H. The course was *approved with contingency*. The revision that the panel would like to see is the following:

- Drop class size to no more than 20 students. If the number is not lowered then provide an explanation of how this course will work with 30 students.
 - Having real discussions with 30 students would be difficult and students could get by doing less work and still receive H credit.
 - Part of the grade is based on participation and they may not all have the opportunity to meet those objectives.
