Katra and Natascha,

On Friday, January 10, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed the resubmission for German 3254H (new course with GE Visual and Performing Arts and GE Diversity—Global Studies).

I am happy to report that the Panel unanimously approved the course. Provided the course request is subsequently approved all the way through the Office of the University Registrar, German 3254H will be a new course with GE Visual and Performing Arts and GE Diversity—Global Studies starting Autumn 2014.

Please know that the GE assessment plan of German 3254H will need to be implemented each time the course is offered and GE data gathered. The Panel wishes to reiterate that for this purpose it is the effectiveness of the course in achieving the GE expected learning outcomes that will need to be assessed (not the broad course goals).

After the second offering of the course, the Department will be asked to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 6 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 75]

Our program assistant Danielle Hogle (hogle.12) can help the Department with any aspect of the GE assessment requirement. Since the course is requesting Honors status, it will next be reviewed by the ASC Honors Panel.
