Dear Alisa,

On Wednesday, September 25th the ASCC Honors Panel reviewed Psych 3313H and Psych 3310H. I am happy to report that Psychology 3310H was *unanimously approved* and will move to the full ASCC for a 2 week comment period. The panel *approved* Psych 3313H with the following *contingencies*:

- Provide the student enrollment limit.
- In the syllabus clearly define the expectations of the student presentations.
- Provide a bibliography in the syllabus to include research articles.
- Use the standard Academic Misconduct statement.
 - “It is the responsibility of the Committee on Academic Misconduct to investigate or establish procedures for the investigation of all reported cases of student academic misconduct. The term “academic misconduct” includes all forms of student academic misconduct wherever committed; illustrated by, but not limited to, cases of plagiarism and dishonest practices in connection with examinations. Instructors shall report all instances of alleged academic misconduct to the committee (Faculty Rule 3335-5-487).
