So many minors, so little time.

I don't know what happened to our response to the PC minor, but we did endorse it and approve the inclusion of our courses. However, we also suggested removing 201, which was twice taught with themes that are appropriate to the minor, but which is more often taught as a general introduction to relations of literature and society. If in the future this or another course is taught with a more narrow and relevant focus, this could be handled by your proposed advising structure. I'd also suggest adding CS 241, Introduction to Asian American Studies (or else cutting 242, the intro to Latino/a studies, as they are more or less symmetrical), and CS 264, Reading Popular Culture (cross-listed with English).

Let me know if you need me to print and send another copy of the concurrence form.

The undergraduate studies committee discuss the proposed minor in popular culture studies at our meeting today.

We congratulate your committee on the excellent proposal. We're pleased to give concurrence, but make the following recommendations:

The Minor should also include

WS 517: Women Film Directors (includes both US non-mainstream and non-US)

WS 576 Women and Visual Culture in Latin America

Further, we believe that WS 517, WS 576, WS 215 and WS 375 (the latter, when taught by Tapia) fulfill the requirement for a **popular culture outside majority-U.S. culture**. In our own department, WS 576, 215, and 375 (when taught by Tapia) fulfill the difference and diversity requirement.

WS 215 Reading Women Writers is a variable topics course, but it always focuses either on US women of color or on international women writers.

I'll get the paperwork signed ASAP, and will have the syllabi for 517 and 576 emailed to you.

Finally--and this latter has less to do with women's studies than with my role in Latino/a Studies--I noticed that there are currently no courses from Spanish and Portuguese listed for the new minor. There are at least three courses, Spanish 330, H565, and H680, which are relevent to popular culture studies. I'll ask Professor Unzueta if he can send you the syllabi for those courses.
