On Friday, September 20, the ASC NMS Panel reviewed a new course request for EEOB 3498 and a course change request for EEOB 4420H.

1. EEOB 3498: The Panel did not take a vote on the proposal but would like the following points to be addressed first.
  - The course is an independent study with assigned lab time. This is a bit confusing. Request to clarify.
  - Panel believes this should be a 3-cr hr course. If unit wants course to be 4 credits, clear justification is needed. See credit hour explanation on Ohio Board of Regents' website: <https://www.ohiohighered.org/calendar-conversion/definition> and <http://regents.ohio.gov/actions/documents/2010/Dir2010-016.pdf>
  - Provide clarification about how elementary statistical analysis is incorporated in the course.

I will return the course in a minute via curriculum.osu.edu for the unit to make the necessary changes.

2. EEOB 4420H: The Panel unanimously approved the request to increase the credit hours from 2 to 3. This course request will next move to the full ASCC for a 2-week comments period.
