This week the ASC Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel reviewed a new course proposal for Public Affairs 4060.

The request was approved with two contingencies and two recommendations:

## Contingencies:

- 1. The amount of time for class meetings should be increased for a 3-credit course or the number of credits should be reduced to 2 credits to meet requirements set by the Ohio Board of Regents.
- 2. Request to obtain concurrences from FAES and Fisher College of Business.

## Recommendations:

- 1. The syllabus should clarify how the 20-minute student presentations will be scheduled in the period designated because there does not appear to be sufficient time.
- 2. The weekly class schedule should be more specific, including dates for when the reflection papers and final paper are due.
