On Monday, December 2, the NMS Panel reviewed 4 new course requests for Math 1135, 1136, 2137, and 2138.

Math 1135 and 1136 were approved with one contingency, namely: Request to specify contact hours on syllabi. Syllabi do not make clear why 5 credit hrs are needed.

Math 2137 and 2138 were unanimously approved.

Furthermore, the Panel had the following recommendation regarding 1136 and 2137: The outlines in the syllabi for 1136 and 2137 state that there will be "roughly 13 weeks of content, leaving 1 week for exams." The Panel thought this was a bit confusing. The syllabi for 1135 and 2138 state that there will be "roughly 14 weeks total; midterms to be inserted as appropriate." The latter phrasing seems more appropriate.

I will return 1135 and 1136 via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the Department to make the necessary changes.
