Alisa,

As you know, yesterday the SBS Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course request for Psychology 5425.

After my phone conversation with you, we changed the wording of the prerequisite to “Permission of instructor or graduate standing.”

The Panel then finished reviewing the course via e-mail. They have unanimously approved the course with one contingency and 2 recommendations/questions:

Contingency: obtain concurrence from the Dept of Neuroscience—COM

Recommendations to clarify some aspects of the syllabus:

- P. 1: course requirements: Provide more details about safety training, group projects, midterm, group participation, and class participation. (Regarding the latter point, the class attendance policy says that, though attendance is mandatory, points are not given for attendance. How is the participation grade given?) Do any of the graded assignments include activities in the lab?
- P. 3: Dr. Li will come as a guest lecturer on weeks 10 and 13. Might be a good idea to explain who Dr. Li is in syllabus.

I will return the course via curriculum.osu.edu to enable the Dept to upload the concurrence.
