The ASCC Honors Panel reviewed Sociology 3463H and did not approve the course based on the following:

- If the instructor wants to admit students to the course that are not in the Honors program they already have the option to do so.
- It is not clear how the proposed change benefits the students or the Honors program.
- The change could make the class fill up faster which could eliminate space for H-students or drop the level of discourse because the lack of screening means that unprepared students may be admitted.
- The ASC Honors Committee and the Honors & Scholars Center must be involved in these types of requests, which alter university-wide standard enrollment prerequisites for honors courses.
